Community Foundation Announces New Grant Opportunity

Springfield – The Community Foundation for the Land of Lincoln is now accepting proposals for the **CFLL Historic Preservation Fund**. The deadline for application is August 1, 2016.

The [CFLL Historic Preservation Fund](#) is an endowment fund established to assist nonprofit organizations in funding historic preservation projects in Springfield, Illinois. Up to \$7,500 will be awarded for the fifth annual grant from this fund. Projects are sought that support the physical improvement of structures and/or promote the issue of historic preservation in Springfield, Illinois.

The CFLL Historic Preservation Fund was established by a Community Foundation for the Land of Lincoln board resolution in 2008 in coordination with an initial contribution from excess funds following the rededication celebration of the Illinois Old State Capitol Building upon its 40th anniversary. Past recipients include Springfield Art Association, Downtown Springfield, Inc. and The Greater Springfield Chamber of Commerce Foundation.

Local nonprofit organizations located in Springfield, Illinois are encouraged to submit a proposal before the August 1, 2016 deadline. Applicants must apply via the Foundation's online system, which can be accessed through its web site at: www.CFLL.org.
